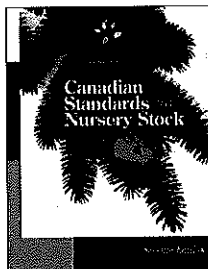

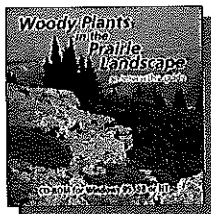

## Woody Plants in the Prairie Landscape - CD Rom By Bill Remphrey

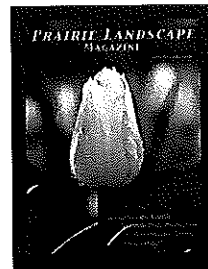

## Prairie Landscape Magazine (LANTA Publication)

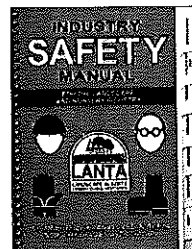

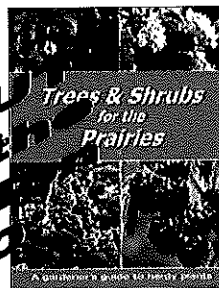
